The Institute of Leadership Training for Teaching Mathematics and Technology at SUNY/College at Old Westbury will continue our leadership training program for 50 mathematics teachers of kindergarten through grade 12. The program is comprised of two separate grade groups, K-6 and 7-12, which meet during the academic year. Each grade group will consist of 15 formal workshop sessions. The Institute has been in operation since 1986 making important contributions to mathematics education on Long Island and New York City offering various workshops for about 1000 elementary and secondary teachers.

Training begins in the fall of 2017 with emphasis placed on the Common Core State Standards for Mathematics. Teachers will be involved in applying problem solving strategies, using manipulatives (including calculators and computers) for instruction, writing lesson plans that align with the standards, and learning techniques to provide in-service training to others. The instructional hands-on manipulative materials will be supplied to all teacher participants.

Superintendents, principals and mathematics chairs/coordinators are encouraged to invite staff members to apply for this program. Each candidate must complete the application endorsed by the school principal or the district superintendent. We urge teachers of all levels and abilities to apply. The program is also available to all current faculty and administration.

Project participants will have a meaningful role in planning, implementing and evaluating the in-service training and will have further opportunities to affect change during the orientation and evaluation sessions.
